General Education Committee Establishment Regulations

December 21, 2020 Passed by the second Academic Affairs Meeting, fall semester, Academic Year 2020-21

Article 1 National Chengchi University (hereinafter referred to as “the University”) establishes the General Education Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”) in accordance with Article 8 of the University’s Organizational Regulations to plan and promote the University’s general education and achieve the goal of holistic education.

Article 2 The functions of the Committee are as follows:

1. Deliberate on the general education system.
2. Revise the general education regulations.
3. Plan the development direction of general education courses.
4. Discuss and amend general education fields.
5. Review general education courses.
6. Address other matters related to general education.

Article 3 To respond to the development of general education courses, the Committee is divided into the following domain groups, responsible for the planning, coordination, research, and review of general education courses in their respective domains:

1. Chinese Language and Literature Domain Group.
2. Foreign Language and Literature Domain Group.
3. Humanities Domain Group.
4. Social Sciences Domain Group.
5. Natural Sciences Domain Group.
6. Information Domain Group.
7. College Education Domain Group.

The directives for each domain group shall be separately determined by the Committee.

Article 4 The Committee consist of several members, with the following composition:

1. A convener, who shall be the Director of the Center for General Education.
2. The convener of each domain group.
3. One representative recommended by each college.
4. Two teacher representatives, recommended by the convener.
5. Two student representatives, recommended by the Student Association.

Article 5 The term of office for the Committee’s convener and the conveners of each domain group shall be based on their respective terms of office; the term for college representatives and

teacher representatives is two years and may be re-elected once; the term for student representatives is one year and may be re-elected once.

Article 6 The Committee shall convene at least once each semester, and the items resolved at the meetings shall be submitted to the Academic Affairs Meeting for review.

Article 7 Instructors for general education courses may be invited by the Committee through consultation with relevant colleges, departments, or institutes for appointment in accordance with the University's regulations on faculty appointment and promotion. This Committee may recommend that relevant colleges, departments, or institutes appoint part-time instructors for general education courses.

Article 8 These directives shall be promulgated and implemented after being passed by the Academic Affairs Meeting, and the same applies for any amendment.
