

Chengchi University Outstanding General Education

Professor Nominee Selection Regulations

Approved in the Academic Affairs Meeting of the 2nd
semester of 2006 on June 4, 2007

Article 1 The following regulations have been drafted in accordance with the ***Ministry of Education National Outstanding General Education Professor Selection and Incentive Guidelines*** in order to encourage outstanding teachers to assist with general education, promote achievements in teaching, and improve the quality of education.

Article 2 These regulations are applicable to full time professors who have taught general education courses for at least six semesters.

Article 3 The Chengchi University Outstanding General Education Professor Selection Committee has been established to select the University's Outstanding General Education Professor.

The General Education Center will nominate 7 committee members, 3 from outside of the University. The director of the General Education Center serves as an ex-officio member, and meeting chairs are selected by committee members themselves. Two thirds of the committee must be present at each meeting. Nominees for Outstanding General Education Professor must receive fifty percent or more approval from the committee.

Article 4 The selection of the University's outstanding general education professor is governed by ***Ministry of Education National Outstanding General Education Professor Selection and Incentive Guidelines***

The Outstanding general Education professor is to be selected as follows:

1. Creation of selection committee
2. Eligible general education professors may submit their credentials to the general education center
3. Each college selects a representative to participate in the selection

Article 5 Selection committee members will review course outlines, teacher evaluations, grades, and other relevant materials to decide on the nominees.

Article 6 The top three nominees for Outstanding General Education Professor will be ranked, with number one being chosen as the University's

nominee. The selected professor is responsible for submitting any further needed information. If the selected candidate declines, then the following candidate will be chosen.

Article 7 Winners of the National Outstanding General Education Professor Award are not eligible for re-selection for three years.

Article 8 Other matters will be handled according to Ministry of Education regulations.

Article 9 These guidelines or their modifications are valid after approval by the General Education Center Committee and the Educational Affairs Committee.
