General Education Committee Domain Group Establishment Directives

- Article 1 To facilitate the planning, coordination, development, review, and deliberation on the entry and exit of additional faculty positions for general education courses in various domains, the General Education Committee of National Chengchi University establishes domain subcommittees in accordance with Article 3 of the National Chengchi University General Education Committee Establishment Regulations.
- Article 2 Each domain group should have one convener, recommended by the Director of the Center for General Education from administrative officers of relevant domain, appointed after the approval and endorsement of the President; the convener's term is aligned with their administrative position.
- Article 3 Each domain group should comprise five to seven members, recommended by the convener from among the University's full-time faculty and researchers, and including one external part-time scholar or expert, serving a term of two years, which may be renewable, and appointed by the President.
The Director of the Center for General Education shall serve as an ex-officio member of each domain group.
- Article 4 Domain groups shall convene at least once each semester, and the resolutions passed in these meetings shall be submitted to the General Education Committee for review.
- Article 5 These directives shall be promulgated and implemented after being passed by the General Education Committee, and the same applies for any amendment.
